4. What part of your daily life do you find frustrating or difficult? Whether or not you have been successful, please describe an obstacle in your life and how you attempted to overcome this challenge.
5. What are your personal goals for the program? pls. leave a line about your willingness to learn the language spoken in your prospective host country and in what languages you will be able to help yourself out throughout the first months. You can certainly also include which courses you are going to take before you leave your home country.
6. Describe yourself as a scholar: What classes do you prefer and why? How do you like school in general? Compared to your classmates, are you a rather good, rather average or rather poor student what grades are concerned? What are your future education or career plans?
